Result

It is clear from the results displayed in the above table that in the modern era of urban and rural students, the average positive effect of social media on teenagers was 23.57 and 23.38 respectively, in which there is a difference of 0.19, this difference is not statistically significant, because obtained critical ratio value of 0.30 at 398 degrees of freedom determined at 0.05 level of significance

The minimum value is less than 1.97. Therefore, on the basis of the above result, it can be concluded that no significant difference was found in the positive effect of social media on adolescents in the modern age of urban and rural students, that is, the positive effect of social media on adolescents in the modern age of students. No significant effect of nature (urban and rural) was found.

Positive impact of social media on urban and rural students in modern era Comparative

The mean of the positive effect of social media on adolescents in the modern age of rural students was found to be higher than the students of urban areas, but there was no significant difference when comparing the means of both the groups by critical ratio test found.

Looking at the above table, it is known that the mean value of positive impact of social media on urban and rural girl students in the modern era was 23.21 and 23.57 respectively, in which there is a difference of 0.36, this difference is not significant from the statistical point of view, because the obtained critical ratio value 0.98 is less than the minimum value of 1.97 set for 0.05 level of significance at 198 degrees of freedom.

Therefore, on the basis of the above result, it can be concluded that no significant difference was found between the positive effect of social media in the modern age of urban and rural girl students, that is, the nature of residence has a significant effect on the positive effect of social media in the modern era of female students. No significant effect of urban and rural was found.

Regarding the positive effect of social media in the modern era of urban and rural girl students

The mean of the positive effect of social media in the modern age of the female students of the urban area was found to be higher than that of the male students of the rural area, but there was no significant difference when comparing the mean of both the groups by critical ratio test.
